ENTREPRENEUR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS

The Women's Business Development Center will deliver and support a cohort workshop series, "Developing Your Child Care Business" to a minimum of 10 participants. JOB READINESS AND ENTRY-LEVEL JOB TRAINING PROGRAMS

Metropolitan Family Services/Financial Opportunity Center (FOC) will offer training to Englewood women with the goal of enrolling a cohort of 15-20 women in its Retail/Customer Service Bridges to Careers Opportunity Program. The BCO program supports Englewood Women with customer service skills needed to obtain or retain employment in multiple industries. FAMILY STRENGTHENING
